- Is located in the southeast corner of Isanti County and open sunrise to sunset all year for hiking, picnicking, birding, cross-country skiing, and canoeing.
- Consists of 254 acres of land, including frontage on two lakes, woods, prairie, and wetlands.
- Has hiking trails, a picnic shelter, a children's play area, 3 boardwalks that allow access across park wetlands, and an observation deck overlooking Horse Leg Lake and the adjoining wetlands.
